APPLICATION INFORMATION SHEET

Greater Oregon Behavioral Health, Inc. (GOBHI) is a private non-profit company that manages a portion of the mental health benefits available under the Oregon Health Plan. The GOBHI Board of Directors and Quality Improvement Committee are seeking applications to fill committee vacancies.

To be eligible to serve on either Board of Directors (BOD) or Quality Improvement Committee (QIC), the applicant must be an Oregon Health Plan (OHP) enrollee, or family member of an Oregon Health Plan enrollee; **and** must reside in a county served by a GOBHI affiliate mental health plan program. Those counties include the following: Union, Clatsop, Columbia, Grant, Harney, Lake, Malheur, Morrow, Wheeler, Baker, Umatilla, Wallowa, Gilliam, and Douglas.

Your role on either QIC or BOD is to interact as an active voting member and participant on either governing committee. In an effort to improve mental health services in a regional mental health care network, these governing committees will benefit from the perspective that consumers receiving benefits from the Oregon Health Plan can bring to committee meetings. Individuals living in communities where our community mental health programs provide services can give an invaluable voice to the QIC and BOD.

The QIC and BOD meet every 3 months. Meetings can range in location from Boardman to Astoria, Oregon, therefore travel is part of the requirement. If you are selected to be a Committee Member, your expenses for attending meetings will be covered by GOBHI. These expenses could include, motel, transportation, food, language interpreter or any other expenses you may have as a result of attending the meetings.

Becoming a member of either committee gives you a position on the Consumer Caucus, which can meet up to 4 times a year. Consumer Caucus meetings will give you an opportunity to be trained on various topics and share information with other Consumer Caucus members who sit on either QIC or BOD. GOBHI will furnish a \$35 stipend for attending each consumer caucus meeting.
