

- **Code:**
 - G9012 - Substance use care coordination: services provided to transition an individual from higher levels of care (inpatient or residential) to lower levels of care. (This service should be provided at discharge, one unit per person per discharge)
- **Unit:** Per Service
- **Level of care:** Residential
- **Provider Type:** Facility
- **OHA Notes:**
 - Residential programs may bill once (1 unit) on the date of discharge.

- **Code:**
 - H0006 - Alcohol and/or drug services; Case management
 - T1016 - Case management
- **Unit:** 15 Minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADC, Certified Recovery Mentor (CRM)

- **Code:**
 - H0018 - Adult A&D residential treatment without room and board (short term 30 days or less)
 - H0019 - Adult A&D residential treatment without room and board (long term longer than 30 days)
- **Unit:** Per service
- **Level of care:** Residential
- **Provider Type:** Facility

- **Code:**
 - H0020 - Alcohol and/or drug services; methadone administration and/or services (provision of the drug by licensed program)
- **Unit:** Per service
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** Licensed Medical Practitioner (LMP), RN
- **OHA Notes:**
 - This is for OTP programs only, as methadone for SUD is only allowable at an OTP site.
 - The medication is administered by LMP/RN.
 - This can also be used for the administration of buprenorphine and suboxone.

- **Code:**
 - H0022 - Alcohol and/or drug intervention service (planned facilitation)
- **Unit:** Per service
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADC, CRM
- **OHA Notes:**
 - Use for planned rapid response not in a treatment plan
 - May be used pre-treatment, post-treatment, and for recovery maintenance
 - Does not require a screening, assessment or SUD dx before or at the time of service
 - Example: Outreach done by CRM's, i.e. probation department with clients who are not enrolled w/ treatment.

- **Code:**
 - H0023 - Behavioral health outreach service (planned approach to reach a targeted population)
- **Unit:** Per service
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADC, CRM
- **OHA Notes:**
 - Outreach may be provided by peers, QMHA/P, CADCs or staff with a mix of these credentials
 - Individuals served do not have to have a SUD diagnosis prior to having an outreach encounter
 - Does not require a screening, assessment or SUD dx before or at the time of service
 - Example: reaching out to client in the ED, corrections facility, or other medical facility, etc.

- **Code:**
 - H0039 - Assertive community treatment, face- to-face, per 15 minutes
- **Unit:** 15 minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADDC

- **Code:**
 - H0050 - Alcohol and/or drug services, brief intervention 15 Minutes
- **Unit:** 15 minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADC
- **OHA Notes:**
 - Use for rapid brief responses not in a treatment plan.
 - May be used pre-treatment, post-treatment, and for recovery maintenance.
 - This code is a brief intervention for a patient in a drug and/or alcohol treatment program.
 - The service may be initiated by the patient or the provider in response to a specific issue.
 - The purpose of the intervention is to provide support and feedback related to chemical dependency issues that are currently affecting the patient and/or family members.
 - This code is reported per 15-minute time increments spent in the intervention service.
 - This would not be a separate billable service in a residential setting. This code is used in an outpatient setting.
- Example: Use for SBIRT and if can't find diagnosis, use H0022

- **Code:**
 - H2010 - Comprehensive medication services
- **Unit:** 15 minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient & Residential
- **Provider Type:** LMP, RN
- **OHA Notes:**
 - Used in both outpatient and residential setting
 - Follow-up and review of medications that have been prescribed for substance use disorder treatment.

- **Code:**
 - H2011 - Crisis intervention services
- **Unit:** 15 minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient & Residential
- **Provider Type:** CADDC

- **Code:**
 - H2014 - Skills training and development
- **Unit:** 15 minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADDC, CRM

- **Code:**
 - H2014 - V1 - Skills training & development (replaced Supported Employment H2023)
- **Unit:** 15 minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADC, CRM
- **OHA Notes:**
 - This is not fidelity based.
 - This is for employment support for Community Integration Services (CIS)
 - Employment/Housing services are only available to individuals that meet the guidelines indicated in the STCs and are individuals that transition from inpatient or residential levels of care.

- **Code:**
 - H2014 - V2 - Skills training & development (replaced Supported Housing H0043)
- **Unit:** 15 minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADC, CRM
- **OHA Notes:**
 - This is not fidelity based.
 - H0043 - Supported housing was replaced with H2014 with modifier V2.
 - The decision was made to use skills training and development instead as it provides the patient with necessary abilities that will enable the individual to live independently and manage his/her illness and treatment.
 - Training focuses on skills for daily living and community integration for patients with functional limitations due to psychiatric disorders.

- **Code:**
 - H2032 - Activity therapy
- **Unit:** 15 minutes
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADC
- **OHA Notes:**
 - Peers can not provider this service, as it is therapy.

- **Code:**
 - H2036 - SUD Day Treatment programs providing ASAM level 2.5 services at least 20 hour per week
- **Unit:** Per service
- **Level of care:** Outpatient
- **Provider Type:** CADC

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
